Until further notice from the Mayor of Clifton, and in accordance with the Resolution of the Architectural Review Board Commission regarding Remote Participation by Electronic Means Policy and the Town Council Continuity of Government Methods, to the Architectural Review Board and Authorizing Remote Participation by Electronic Means Without a Physical Quorum Being Present Pursuant to Virginia Law, the Town of Clifton Architectural Review Board is holding all Meetings noticed herein electronically for the purpose of continuity of government of the Town of Clifton.

The meetings will be conducted using Zoom teleconferencing audio and video service, and connection information will be provided to members of the public to afford the opportunity to citizens to witness the operation of the Town of Clifton government. Present: Royce Jarrendt, Chair; Phyllis Lovett; Jeff Stein; Geri Yantis.

Staff: Amanda Christman, Town Clerk.

Absent: Council Representative Member Regan McDonald; Phoebe Peterson.

The Regular Meeting was called to order by Chair Jarrendt at 7:31 PM.

Order of Business:

1. Donald Gibson, The Hair Garage/12644 Chapel Road: Business Signage.

See attached application.

It was noted that the sign size is appropriate, and that it is to be mounted by a metal bracket on the side-elevation of the building, and the "Open" arrow sign is to be permanently removed. The phone number for the business is not approved to be on the sign.

- Member Yantis moved to approve the sign with the stipulation that the phone number be omitted, seconded by Member Stein. The motion was approved by poll, 4-0.
- 2. Royce Jarrendt for Dianne Charneco/12851 Redbird Ridge Road: Addition & Modifications to the existing structure.

See attached application.

The proposed addition and modification to the existing structure is to be constructed with asphalt shingles to match the existing, composite fascia & cornice trim to match existing, composite T&G vertical siding, stucco to match existing, wood doors, metal garage door to match existing, composite railing, and composite Windsor window product to be painted to match existing.

- Member Stein moved to approve the application as submitted, seconded by Member Lovett. The motion was approved by poll, 3-0-1 (Chair Jarrendt abstained).
- 3. David Guglielmi, Infill By Design/7184 Clifton Road: Guardrail.

See attached design sheet.

It was noted that a height of 36" would look better for a pedestrian guardrail, be less visible from the street and conforms with residential building code, unless the owners prefer the 42" height as shown on the design sheet. The owners indicated that they prefer the 36" height. Mr. Guglielmi noted that he is not sure how long the rail will be, since that requirement will be made by Fairfax County. Chair Jarrendt noted that location and structural stability is outside of the ARB's purview.


- Member Stein moved to approve a 36" tall pedestrian guardrail consisting of black metal, seconded by Member Yantis. The motion was approved by poll, 4-0.
- 4. Business Sign Audit Project.

The Board discussed the specifics of the planned email that will be sent out to all business owners notifying them that the Governor's state of emergency declaration expires on June 30, 2021, and that all temporary signage posted during the COVID-19 must now be removed or approved by the ARB.

In addition, a line will be added to the COA application to allow for HOA approvals where applicable.

 - Member Yantis moved to approve the April 2021 Minutes with one revision for clarity, seconded by Member Lovett. The motion was approved by poll, 4-0.
